## Most Innovative Service Improvement Project Award – SLCIM 2026

This prestigious award recognizes Physicians in Internal Medicine who have demonstrated exceptional commitment to enhancing clinical services in Sri Lanka through innovative, impactful, and sustainable projects.

Eligible projects must have been **initiated** within **1<sup>st</sup> of January 2023** to **1<sup>st</sup> of August 2025** period and **completed** between **1<sup>st</sup> of August 2025** and **31<sup>st</sup> of July 2026**, and must have been led and executed by a **Physician in Internal Medicine**.

In addition to showcasing innovation, the award aims to highlight projects that have contributed meaningfully to the standardization of patient care and improvement in measurable patient outcomes.

### The applicant must provide the following documentation:

- **A summary of the project** (maximum 1000 words) clearly outlining the *problem, objectives, interventions, outcomes, and how the project contributed to improving standard practices and patient outcomes*. Use Times New Roman, font size 12, double-spaced.
- **Pictorial evidence** (e.g., flowcharts, before-and-after comparisons, audit results) showing the progression and impact of the project, *submitted as a PowerPoint presentation*.
- **A letter from the Head of Institution** where the project was carried out confirming the authenticity of the work, its contribution to service improvement, and the applicant's role.

- **An up-to-date CV** of the applicant.
- **A soft copy of all the above** should be submitted to [simcon@slcim.lk](mailto:simcon@slcim.lk), with the subject line "**Most Innovative SIP**" on or before **31<sup>st</sup> July 2026**.
