



SLCIM Research Grants 2023

SLCIM research grants are awarded to both SLCIM members and associate members to carry out their research. The main objective of this research grant is to improve the research activities of the members and the associated members of SLCIM. By supporting research among the members, SLCIM expects improvement in the quality, effectiveness, accessibility, and cost-effectiveness of health care in Sri Lanka.

Details

- Each grant is worth up to the maximum of Rs 500,000 (the amount will be decided by the SLCIM council depending on the budget of the research and will be paid in instalments).
- 03 grants are available
- Can be utilised for expenses such as chemicals, other lab expenditures, salaries for research assistance (except honorarium for the patients)

Eligibility:

- The main applicants should be a member or an associate member of the SLCIM
- At least 50% of the investigators should be members or associate members of the SLCIM
- Should be able to complete the project in six months' time
- Priorities will be given to those, who have experience and sufficient institutional support to carry out the proposed work

Application Deadline: July 31st 2023

Application (Please download the application at www.sl cim.lk)

- Should apply with a cover letter addressed to secretary SLCIM along with duly filled application form, properly written research proposal and evidence of ERC approval or pending approval.

- The findings of the research should be presented at the SIMCON 2024 as a poster or oral presentation.
